It may lead to closure of your exam session.- You must maintain integrity of the exam. Resorting to any unfair methods or violation of rules during the exam may lead to your disqualification. Your exam session may be recorded for proctoring purposes. Use of calculator device or apps prohibited.

What is Grand Finale?

Syllabus, study material and marking system

- **To prepare for Grand Finale, you may purchase past 5 years Grand Finale papers online.** Login to your account at www.ignitedmindlab.com/students with the registration number and password and buy the papers which will be immediately available in your account after successful payment. Solving past papers is the best way to prepare for Grand Finale.
- Negative marking applicable in Grand Finale. Every wrong answer will carry 25% negative marks for that question

When will be the Grand Finale held?

- Grand Finale will be held **ONLINE** by Ignited Mind Lab
- Date: **Sunday, 4th February 2024**
- Duration: 45 minutes (50 questions, 100 marks)
10 Questions of 1 mark each, 30 Questions of 2 Marks each, and 10 Questions of 3 Marks

Online examination and Proctoring

- Proctoring techniques will be used to maintain integrity of the examination
- Candidate will be disqualified if found to indulge in any malpractice or violate any rules
- **Zero tolerance for violations**

Grand Finale Prizes

- All participants of Grand Finale will get Certificate of Merit
- Cash prizes: First Prize - Rs. 10000, Second Prize - Rs. 5000, and Third Prize - Rs. 3000
- Ranks and prize positions are primarily decided on the basis of Grand Finale marks. In case of a tie, first round marks will be considered to break tie and decide prizes.
- If a tie for any prize is not resolved, the prize money will be recomputed for all prizes and divided among the winners. Please refer to our website for more details.

Strict action against unfair practices during the test:

The violations during the online test include face detection failure, detection of multiple faces (persons), moving away from camera, camera not connected, Mic not connected etc. in addition to the other unfair practices adopted during the examination.

The smart proctoring system detects violations and informs the human proctor. The proctor will go through the evidence from the recorded pictures, screenshots, video and audio evidence if any and may impose penalty in the form of negative marks not exceeding 10 marks.
